Step 1: Check daily activities and disaster risks

Check your daily activities, flood risk, and evacuation for (1) through (4).

(1) Have you ever been evacuated due to heavy rain?

Step 2: Evacuation Switch Search

For (1) through (4), think about or research and fill in what triggers the evacuation based on your knowledge.

(1) Local conditions

Let's think about what happens to familiar places when heavy rain falls.

Circumstances, lore, etc. during heavy rain

Ex. Dangerous if the waterway next to the house overflows; Dangerous if valley water from the mountains begins to flow in an unusual direction; If it crosses the yellow line of the levee

(2) Actions around

What do people in the community and those close to you do when we need to evacuate?

Behavior of local residents, friends, etc.

Ex. If a call for evacuation was made in the community; If a friend contacts you and asks you to evacuate; If the power was out in the area and a police car came and called for evacuation

(3) Evacuation Information

Evacuation information to guide your evacuation

- Alert Level 3 Evacuation of the elderly, etc.
- Alert Level 4 Evacuation instruction
- Alert Level 5 Emergency Safety Measures

(Supplemental) Observation Information

Ex. Hourly rainfall Water level Soil water index Tide level
